Dear General Manager:

Our records indicate that you are using a version of ProtoBase[®] software that is listed by VISA as a Vulnerable Payment Application. VISA has mandated that these versions of software no longer be used by merchants as of January 1, 2008.

If you are no longer using this software or have upgraded to a version of ProtoBase 4.81 or higher, and PbAdmin 5.01 or higher please update your information online (<http://www.protobase.com/visafall>). Otherwise, your business will be reported to VISA as potentially using a vulnerable payment application.

If you are using a product listed by VISA as Vulnerable, ProtoBase Versions 4.7x - 4.80.xx and PbAdmin 4.3 - 5.00.xx, you must upgrade by December 31st 2007. If you do not, SDC will terminate your maintenance agreement and report you to VISA as using a vulnerable payment application.

After multiple attempts to notify your organization about the vulnerability of using non-compliant ProtoBase applications, consider this your final notice. Southern DataComm, Inc. will no longer support and relinquishes any and all responsibility of any further unauthorized use of all ProtoBase vulnerable payment applications. From this point forward, SDC is obligated to report to VISA and your acquirer that you have not acknowledged the necessary update(s) to become compliant.
